

## Level 3 Advanced Apprenticeship in Fenestration Installation (QCF)



### About the course

The Level 3 Advanced Apprenticeship in Fenestration Installation (QCF) is a qualification for those working as Conservatory Installers and Window and Door Installers and will demonstrate their competence of fenestration installation. The course is made of qualifications built together creating a framework that includes Functional Skills in English and Maths, a Diploma in Fenestration Installation (Competency Based) and a Certificate in Glass Related Operations (Knowledge based). The mandatory units cover communication; health and safety; transporting, handling and positioning and materials; components and installation requirements. The three optional groups cover preparing, installing and post installation. Objectives of this qualification include meeting relevant programmes of learning and supporting a role in the workplace.

### Structure of Course

To achieve this qualification the learner must achieve all mandatory and optional units agreed via competence based observation and knowledge based assessments including passing the relevant Functional Skills grade in both English and Maths.

### Assessment

All units in this qualification are assessed by portfolio. Evidence for this qualification must come from the learner's consistent performance in the workplace and must meet the requirements of the Proskills QCF Assessment. Further guidance for each unit is available upon request. All Assessment Criteria must be met in each relevant unit to achieve this qualification.
