

## Level Apprenticeship in Fascia, Soffit & Bargeboard Installation (QCF)



### About the course

The Level Apprenticeship in Domestic Fascia, Soffit and Bargeboard Installation (QCF) is a competence-based qualification for individuals working as installers or fitters on customer's premises, removing and installing fascias, soffits and bargeboards in glazing. It provides learners with formal recognition of their competence. All learners will cover the essential areas of communication, working with others, health and safety, installations, confirming requirements, handling materials and equipment and preparatory tasks. Through the optional units, learners can also cover dealing with asbestos cement, dismantling equipment, removing materials and handover to customers. The objectives of the qualification include meeting relevant programmes of learning, supporting a role in the workplace and preparing learners to progress to a qualification in the same subject area but at a higher level or requiring more specific knowledge, skills and understanding.

### Structure of Course

To achieve this qualification the learner must achieve all mandatory and optional units agreed via competence based observation and knowledge based assessments including passing the relevant Functional Skills grade in both English and Maths.

### Assessment

All units in this qualification are assessed by portfolio. Evidence for this qualification must come from the learner's consistent performance in the workplace and must meet the requirements of the Proskills QCF Assessment. Further guidance for each unit is available upon request. All Assessment Criteria must be met in each relevant unit to achieve this qualification.
