

## Level 2 Diploma for Children and Young Peoples Workforce (QCF)

### About the course

This qualification is intended to guide and assess development of knowledge and skills relating to children and young people and will provide progression to the early learning and childcare, social care and learning development and support services workforces. The qualification confirms competence under supervision in these areas where appropriate.

### Structure of Course

Level 2 Certificate for the Children and Young People's Workforce (QCF) is a 35 credit and 267 guided learning hour (GLH) qualification that consists of 13 Mandatory units and achieve 4 credits from the optional units specific to their role

### Assessment

This competence-based qualification is designed to be assessed in the candidate's workplace as they undertake their normal work role.

The evidence must at all times reflect the policies and procedures of the workplace as informed by current legislation, the relevant service standards and codes of practice for the sector. The majority of assessment for this competence-based qualification will take place in the workplace under real work conditions, using observations by a qualified assessor and/or testimony from an expert witness, work products etc. All the identified assessment criteria must be evidenced and a holistic approach to assessment is encouraged

### Entry Requirements

There are no formal entry requirements, however you will be asked to carry out a diagnostic assessment in maths and English and must show that you are working at level 1 or above. A skills scan will also be completed to ensure that your role meets the specific requirements of the qualification.

### Employment Information

You will need to be working in a relevant Children and Young peoples setting to meet the standards of this qualification.

Continuous throughout the year as we run a rolling programme
