

Level 3 Diploma for Children and Young People's Workforce (QCF)

About the course

This qualification is for people who work with children from birth to 19 years old (and their families) - in social care and learning and development and support settings. The qualification confirms competence in these areas where appropriate and serves as the required qualification (for all new practitioners) for registration and regulatory requirements in the sector.

(The child care pathway has been removed from this qualification and a new Level 3 Diploma in Children's Learning and Development (Early Years Educator) is now available)

Structure of Course

Level 3 Diploma for the Children and Young People's Workforce (QCF) is a 65 credit and 443 guided learning hour (GLH) qualification that consists of 11 Mandatory units, learners must then choose 13 credits from their chosen pathway; Social Care or Learning Development and Support. A further 25 credits to be chosen from optional units for all pathways

Assessment

This competence-based qualification is designed to be assessed in the candidate's workplace as they undertake their normal work role.

The evidence must at all times reflect the policies and procedures of the workplace as informed by current legislation, the relevant service standards and codes of practice for the sector. The majority of assessment for this competence-based qualification will take place in the workplace under real work conditions, using observations by a qualified assessor and/or testimony from an expert witness, work products etc. All the identified assessment criteria must be evidenced and a holistic approach to assessment is encouraged

Entry Requirements

There are no formal entry requirements, however you will be asked to carry out a diagnostic assessment in maths and English and must show that you are working at level 2 or above. A skills scan will also be completed to ensure that your role meets the specific requirements of the qualification.
