

Level 2 Certificate in Understanding Dignity and Safeguarding in Adult Social Care

About the course

This qualification aims to give learners knowledge and understanding of the key principles of dignity, duty of care and safeguarding as applied to adult health and social care. Learners will investigate the principles and how they are applied in everyday work contexts. They will also have an opportunity to examine the dilemmas and consequences that can arise when these principles are not upheld.

The objectives of this qualification are to prepare learners for further training and to support a role in the workplace where the individual may work or interact with vulnerable adults.

Structure of Course

The level 2 Certificate in Understanding Dignity and Safeguarding in Adult Social Care is 16 credit and 145 guided learning hour (GLH) qualifications that consists of 4 mandatory units.

Assessment

This qualification is a paper based distance learning programme. An assessor will be allocated to you to assess the units and give feedback and corrections when required.
