

## Level 2 Certificate in Equality and Diversity

### About the course

This Qualification aims to: introduce the concepts of equality and diversity in a variety of environments including society, the community and the workplace, highlight how stereotyping and labelling affect individuals, outline the effects of prejudice and discrimination, allow the learner to examine rights and responsibilities, stress the importance of taking individual responsibility and action to help and support others, provide a basis for further study and/or career development.
