

## Level 2 Certificate in Principles of Working with Individuals with Learning Disabilities

### About the course

This qualification aims to give learners knowledge and understanding to work with individuals with learning disabilities or difficulties. They will explore the principles of safeguarding and positive risk taking and gain awareness of the autistic spectrum.

The objectives of this qualification are to prepare learners for employment and to support a role in the workplace where the individual may work or interact with people with learning disabilities. This is primarily for those within healthcare and social care but may also be useful to those working in education or housing support roles.

### Structure of Course

The level 2 Certificate in the Principles of Working with Individuals with Learning Disabilities is a 17 credit and 143 guided learning hour (GLH) qualifications that consists of 6 mandatory units.

### Assessment

This qualification is a paper based distance learning programme. An assessor will be allocated to you to assess the units and give feedback and corrections when required.

### Entry Requirements

There are no formal entry requirements.

### Employment Information

You do not need to be working in a specific setting to complete this qualification

### Start Dates

Continuous throughout the year as we run a rolling programme

### Duration

Approximately 4months

### Progression
