

Level 2 Apprenticeship Diploma in Kitchen Services (QCF)

About the course

The Level 2 NVQ Diploma in Kitchen Service (QCF) is designed for learners employed in catering roles such as a kitchen assistant, school or general cook, team member or chef, who need to develop or consolidate their skills. This is a work-based qualification, which will allow learners to develop knowledge, understanding and skills essential for working in a catering environment, such as a food production and cooking and working with others and improving their own performance.

Structure of Course

A minimum total of 37 credits must be achieved to gain the qualification as follows:

Group A - 10 credits

Group B - 11 credits

Group C - 16 credits

Minimum Guided Learning Hours (GLH) are 309

Maximum Guided Learning Hours (GLH) are 323.

Assessment

The overall grade for each qualification is a 'pass'. The learner must achieve all the required units within the specified qualification structure.

To pass a unit the learner must:

- Achieve all the specified learning outcomes
- Satisfy all the assessment criteria by providing sufficient and valid evidence for each criterion
- Show that the evidence is their own.

The qualifications are designed to be assessed:

- In the workplace or
- In conditions resembling the workplace, as specified in the assessment requirements/strategy for the sector, or
- As part of a training programme.

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Course Modules

Mandatory Group –

- Maintenance of a safe, hygienic and secure working environment
- Working effectively as part of a hospitality team
- Maintain food safety when storing, preparing and cooking food

Group B - optional units

- Cook vegetables
- Prepare and finish simple salad and fruit dishes
- Prepare and cook fish
- Prepare and cook meat and poultry
- Prepare hot and cold sandwiches
- Present menu items according to a defined brand standard
- Maintain an efficient use of resources in the kitchen
- Provide a counter and takeaway service.
