

Level 2 Apprenticeship in International Trade and Logistics Operations (QCF) (Logistics)

About the course

The Intermediate Apprenticeship in International Trade and Logistics Operations contains a vocational qualification at Level 2, and Functional Skills (English, mathematics and ICT), at QCF Levels 1 and 2.

Structure of Course

To achieve the International trade and Logistics Operations Apprenticeship, you will need to complete the qualifications listed below, to meet the minimum credit points:

Level 2 Certificate in International Trade and Logistics Operations (ITLO) (**21 credits**), Functional Skills Level 1 OR 2 in English* (**5 credits**), Functional Skills Level 1 OR 2 in Mathematics* (**5 credits**), Functional Skills Level 1 OR 2 in Information Communications Technology ICT* (**5 credits**).

Assessment

Providers MUST ensure that Apprentices achieve at least 10 credits for competence and at least 10 credits for knowledge when selecting units to meet the requirements of the SASE. The framework totals 41 credits which includes competence, knowledge, the ERR qualification and the three Functional Skills of English, Math's and ICT. This framework exceeds the minimum of 37 credits set by the SASE.
