

Level 3 Advanced Apprenticeship in Warehousing and Storage (QCF) (Logistics)

About the course

The Level 3 Diploma in Warehousing and Storage (QCF) has been designed for learners who work or want to work as a senior team member in a warehousing operation within the logistics sector. It allows learners to develop and practise the skills required for career progression in the logistics sector.

Structure of Course

A minimum total of 40 credits must be achieved to gain the qualification as follows: All 16 credits must be achieved from Group M, and the remaining credits from Groups A, B, C, D and E. Learners must achieve a minimum of: 9 credits from Group A, 4 credits from Group B, 6 credits from Group C, 3 credits from Group D, 2 credits from Group E.

Assessment

The learner may produce evidence from a range of examples (as outlined above) which should be recorded in some form. A record of evidence will confirm to the assessor their confidence in the learner's breadth and depth of knowledge and understanding in being able to competently meet the functional requirements of all the units.

The assessor will need to be assured that the learner can:

- Meet all the learning outcomes of a unit
- Pass all the assessment criteria of a unit

An assessor may request additional evidence if they are not satisfied with the evidence presented by the learner. If this occurs, it may need to be agreed in partnership with the learner and the assessor.

Group M – Mandatory units

- Contribute to the provision of customer service in logistics operations
- Provide leadership for your team in logistics operations
- Supervise the receipt, storage, or dispatch of goods
- Take responsibility for health, safety and security in your team.

Group A – Optional Units

- Moving and or handlings goods in logistics operations
- Use equipment to move goods in logistics operations
- Check stock levels and stock records
- Maintain the safety and security of hazardous goods and materials in logistics operations
- Process returned goods in logistics operations
- Sort goods and materials for recycling or disposal of logistics operations
