

Level 2 Award in Security Guarding (QCF) (Security)

About the course

The Edexcel BTEC Level 2 Award in Security Guarding (QCF) is designed for people who require a licence to practise in order to work as a contracted security guard. The qualification is endorsed by the Security Industry Authority (SIA) and learners who have completed it successfully can then apply to the SIA for a licence.

Structure of Course

The Edexcel BTEC Level 2 Award in Security Guarding (QCF) is a 26 guided learning hour (GLH) qualification that consists of three mandatory units, providing for a combined total of three credits.

Assessment

The overall grading is a pass, based upon the successful completion of the minimum credit.

Learners must pass three mandatory units to achieve the Edexcel BTEC Level 2 Award in Security Guarding (QCF).

Each unit is assessed by means of a test that is set and marked by Edexcel and which will be administered by the centre. The tests will provide the only necessary assessment for these units.
