

Level 2 Certificate in Spectator Safety (QCF) (Security)

About the course

This qualification is aimed at anyone working or wishing to work in the match day and events stewarding industry. This could include a variety of sporting or musical events. The qualification meets the requirements laid out in the Football Licensing Authority's Guide to Safety at Sports Grounds (known as the Green Guide). It provides the knowledge and competency components for the Intermediate Level Apprenticeship in Spectator Safety.

Structure of Course

The Level 2 Certificate in Spectator Safety is a 85 guided learner hour (GLH) qualification that consists of six mandatory units, providing for a combined total of 29 credits.

Assessment

The overall grading is a pass, based upon the successful completion of the minimum credit. Learners must pass all mandatory units to achieve the Level 2 Certificate in Spectator Safety

Course Modules

Mandatory units

- Prepare for spectator events
- Control the entry, exit and movement of people at spectator events
- Monitor spectators and deal with crowd problems
- Support the work of the team and organisation
- Help to manage conflict
- Deal with accidents and emergencies
